

Buckinghamshire County Junior Grading Guidelines

A Grade

Players with a high national ranking. Regular participation in Silver ES events.

Players who represent the Aspire South Region as well as the County.

Players who represent their club in the Bucks (adult) County League.

B Grade

Players with a national ranking or working towards a national ranking and who regularly compete at Bronze ES events.

Players who represent the County or who train with the ICC County Squads.

Players who represent their club in the County Junior Leagues.

C Grade

Players who are competing at ES Copper Level.

Players who attend regular club based coaching and are playing in or pushing for a place in their clubs County Junior League Team.

D Grade

Players learning the full court game. Able to hold a rally, with generally good serves and an ability to volley the return of serve.

Players who are starting to attend weekly club coaching sessions or play with their school.

Players generally using the Dunlop single yellow dot ball.

E Grade

Players who are just starting out. Playing in the front $\frac{3}{4}$'s of the court.

Players generally using the Dunlop blue dot Max ball or the Dunlop red dot Progress ball.
